RECOGNIZE, REPORT AND PREVENT ABUSE, NEGLECT AND EXPLOITATION

- Immediately take action to stop the mistreatment.
- Comfort and reassure the victim(s).
- Give first aid if there is an injury.
- Arrange for a nurse to examine the victim, if there is possible injury.
- Secure evidence.
- Immediately report to the facility director/designee and APS PI.
- Assist a visitor, family member, or resident to make notifications, if they need help.
- Fill out proper paperwork.
- The Psychologist is to complete an Emotional Security Assessment within 24 hours.
